
Eagle Vision: Four-Time Emmy® Award winner Bryan H. Shepard shares his transformational story about how eagles and nature helped him overcome a visual disability in a newly published book

PRNewswire/ — Diagnosed with a visual disability as a child, Bryan H. Shepard turned to unlikely sources for help, eagles and nature, which led him to a remarkable career in visual media that to date has resulted in four Emmy® Awards and 14 Telly Awards. Shepard chronicles his transformational story of discovery in Eagle Spirit for Sovereignty: Wisdom of the Great Masters and Natural World on Freedom, Power and Self-Preservation, a new book published by EagleVision Entertainment Corp.

Eagles are known for their exceptional visual acuity above all other creatures. Undismayed by his own visual challenges, Shepard studied and learned from eagles. Serving as a mentor and teacher, eagles have provided lessons throughout Shepard's life on how to anticipate and overcome any obstacles that



"I share the lessons I have learned from the eagle and the natural world that have made the greatest impact on my own personal quest for sovereignty. A primary goal in my writing and compiling of this material is to provide a mental and physical roadmap for what I felt was missing in my own formative journey. It also serves as a continuous reminder to keep me progressing in a positive direction toward spiritual realization and my ultimate personal goal of spiritual sovereignty," wrote Shepard in the book's introduction.

Eagle Spirit for Sovereignty: Wisdom of the Great Masters and Natural World on Freedom, Power and Self-Preservation weaves together Shepard's personal story of his triumphant 36-year journey through the entertainment industry in Hollywood with anecdotes from historical figures and ancient philosophers along with lessons from nature in a compelling treatise on personal sovereignty, which he calls, "spiritual sovereignty."

"The concept of sovereignty of your spirit stems from the recognition that each person is independent and has supreme authority over their self. Nation-states are but a substitution to what inherently exists at the individual level," wrote Shepard.

Despite being celebrated as a national symbol for the nearly 250 years since the nation's founding, the bald eagle was only formally recognized by law as the **U.S. National Bird in December 2024**. However, the eagle has long been revered in cultures around the world throughout history as a beacon of freedom, strength, and independence. Shepard explains why in his book.

"The bald eagle is a glowing example of how the natural world at large can guide the ordinary, everyday individual to freedom and personal sovereignty. Most importantly, the natural world is a person's direct link to self-awareness," said Shepard.

Shepard believes that in a rapidly changing world, as we face deep questions driven by technology, climate, and our own mortality, now is a critical time to connect with the nature that surrounds us. His book is purposed with fostering the human connection with nature and the animal world.

"Bringing more awareness to animals as spiritual teachers is my way of sharing, paying forward, and most importantly, honoring the lessons of all animals past and present, and especially the majestic and regal eagle," wrote Shepard.
